This premise in the surrounded-by-water Throgs Neck section of the Bronx was originally an Italian bakery, founded in 1922. The flagship of a three-restaurant fleet moved into the space three years ago, retaining the bakery's name and its coal-fired oven, as well. Now the oven is used to turn out thin-crust pies, reverently in the style of the old pizza masters of Brooklyn and Manhattan. The rest of the menu is absurdly diverse, though at its heart is the old Italian American slate of dishes that includes eggplant rollatini, escarole and white-bean soup, and red-sauced pastas. \$\$ v
